	Paddle Compton's Rapid on the South Fork (MP 17).
	Hike to The Rock Maze on Riven Rock Mountain.
	Trailbike the Narrowback/Festival/ Trail .
	Paddle at Switzer Dam .
	Bike from Briery Branch UM Church to Reddish Knob , and back.
	Jump in the Fridleys Gap swimming hole in May (never warm!).
	Walk the Sinks of Gandy Cave in WV.
	Complete the Commando Crawl in Glade Cave with no lights.
	Camp on the boulder meadow of the Whispering Spruce Trail at Spruce Knob, WV.
	Trailbike the Seneca Creek Trail to Judy Springs Walk-in Campground.
	Climb one of these Lower Hidden Rocks classics: Snowblower (5.9), Walk in the Park (5.4).
	Jump in the Seneca Rocks swimming hole .
	Climb any route to the Seneca Rocks South Summit .
	Complete the NROCKS (WV) Via Ferrata or Canopy Tour .
	Hike the Stony Man/LSM loop in Shen. Ntl. Park.
	Read Chapts. 1-3 in the Climbing ROCKingham County guidebook .
	Complete 3 trash pickup efforts at well-trafficked trailheads or boat launches.
	Complete the Old Rag Mtn. hiking loop in SNP.
	Hike the Cedar Run/White Oak Canyon loop in SNP.
	Attain or renew your Wilderness First Aid certification .
	Watch a sunset from Reddish Knob .

	Take a younger person on an outdoor adventure.
	Boulder traverse (climb) all the way around the High Knob Fire Tower .
	Build a fire with 3 matches or less using all natural materials (no artificial accelerant or paper), and burning up to thumb-sized wood.
	Hike or bike to the Stone Living Room above the Slate Springs waterfall.
	Visit Hidden Roofs and climb one of the recently developed routes there.
	Watch a sunrise from the Storybook Trail deck.
	Attend a Ranger-Talk in SNP .
	Register your sighting (or take a picture) of a black bear, a fox, a coyote, or a venomous snake (Copperhead or Timber Rattler) in the wild.
	Overnight camp somewhere in the GWNF
